In order to make this show happen and for it to be run in a timely manner, we need volunteers at each show. By volunteering, you are also helping keep costs down for all of us. Volunteer Requirements:

- ½ to 1 credit per volunteer slot depending on duty; 2 volunteer credits required for yearend awards
- Single memberships: require 2 credits per show year for year-end awards
- <u>Family memberships:</u> require 2 credits per show year by at least 1 family member on that membership
- <u>For youth memberships</u>: at least one parent or guardian shall earn volunteer credits for that youth

Regarding All Volunteers Whether Members Or Nonmembers

- (Youth under 15 years old must be supervised by their parent or guardian to volunteer & have a signed release waiver by their parent or guardian)
- (Youth 15 17 years old must have a signed release waiver by their parent or guardian)
- o (18 years old & over must have signed the release waiver)
- o Can have a family member or friend work for you
- Release waivers must be turned in for nonmembers volunteering before their volunteer position starts (Age rules listed above apply)
